(SPRINGFIELD, COLORADO) The Baca County Division of Emergency Management is urging citizens in the county to run a slow stream of water from their faucets in their homes tonight due to the low temperatures that are associated with the storm moving in.

The National Weather Service out of Pueblo is predicting the low to be around five degrees Fahrenheit, with wind chill values of 10 below zero.

At a minimum, run the tap furthest from where the water supply line enters the home. Running a little bit of water through the faucets may prevent the pipes from freezing and will also assist in keeping the water mains in towns from freezing.
